




Figure 1a: Connection scheme for HD67B71-232-A1




Figure 1b: Connection scheme for HD67B71-485-A1




Figure 1c: Connection scheme for HD67B71-422-A1





FUNCTION MODES:

The device has got two functions mode depending of the position of the Dip1 of 'Dip-Switch A':

- ▶ The first, with Dip1 in Off position (factory setting), is used for the normal working of the device.
- → The second, with Dip1 in On position, is used for upload the Project/Firmware.

For the operations to follow for the updating (see 'UPDATE DEVICE' section).

According to the functioning mode, the LEDs will have specifics functions (see 'LEDS' section).







ETHERNET:


The Ethernet connection must be made using Connector3 or Connector4 of HD67B71-xxx-A1 with at least a Category 5E cable. The maximum length of the cable should not exceed 100m. The cable has to conform to the T568 norms relative to connections in cat.5 up to 100 Mbps. To connect the device to an Hub/Switch is recommended the use of a straight cable, to connect the device to a PC/PLC/other is recommended the use of a cross cable.



RS232:

The connection from RS232 socket to a serial port (example one from a personal computer) must be made with a Null Modem cable (a serial cable where the pins 2 and 3 are crossed).

It is recommended that the RS232 cable not exceed 15 meters.





RS485:

For terminate the RS485 line with a 120Ω resistor it is necessary to put ON dip 1, like in figure.



The maximum length of the cable should be 1200m (4000 feet).


- ▶ Belden: p/n 8132 2x 28AWG stranded twisted pairs conductor + foil shield + braid shield;
- ▶ Belden p/n 82842 2x 24AWG stranded twisted pairs conductor + foil shield + braid shield;
- → Tasker: p/n C521 1x 24AWG twisted pair conductor + foil shield + braid shield;
- ▶ Tasker: p/n C522 2x 24AWG twisted pairs conductor + foil shield + braid shield.

RS422:

For terminate the RS485 line with a 120Ω resistor it is necessary to put ON dip 1 for T line and/or put ON dip 2 for R line, like in figure.

USE OF COMPOSITOR SW67B71:

To configure the Converter, use the available software that runs with Windows called SW67B71. It is downloadable on the site www.adfweb.com and its operation is described in this document. (This manual is referenced to the last version of the software present on our web site). The software works with MSWindows (XP, Vista, Seven, 8, 10; 32/64bit).

When launching the SW67B71, the window below appears (Fig. 2).

It is necessary to have installed .Net Framework 4.

NEW CONFIGURATION / OPEN CONFIGURATION:

The "New Configuration" button creates the folder which contains the entire device's configuration.



A device's configuration can also be imported or exported:

- ▼ To clone the configurations of a programmable "PROFINET Master / Modbus Slave -Converter" in order to configure another device in the same manner, it is necessary to maintain the folder and all its contents;
- → To clone a project in order to obtain a different version of the project, it is sufficient to duplicate the project folder with another name and open the new folder with the button "Open Configuration".



SET COMMUNICATION:

This section define the fundamental communication parameters of two buses, PROFINET and Modbus.

By Pressing the "**Set Communication**" button from the main window for SW67B71 (Fig. 2) the window "Set Communication" appears (Fig. 3).

The means of the fields for "PROFINET Master" are:

- In the fields "IP Address" the IP address for PROFINET side of the converter is defined;
- → In the fields "SubNet Mask" the SubNet Mask for PROFINET side of the converter is defined;
- → In the fields "Gateway" the default gateway of the net is defined. This feature can be enabled or disabled pressing the Check Box field. This feature is used for going out of the net;

The means of the fields for "Modbus Slave" are:

- ▶ In the field "Serial" the serial lien to use for Modbus communication is defined;
- In the field "Baudrate" the baudrate for the serial line is defined;
- In the field "Parity" the parity of the serial line is defined;
- ▼ In the field "Stop Bits" the number of Stop Bits is defined;
- ▼ In the field "ID Device" the address of serial Modbus device is defined;
- → If the field "Read with Input Register / Status Function" is checked, it is possible to read the Input bytes of PROFINET side with Input Registers (Function 04) and write the Output bytes of PROFINET side with Holding Registers (Function 06/16). The Output bytes are readable with Function 03. Otherwise, only Holding Registers will be used and the Output bytes of PROFINET side cannot be read back.

PROFINET ACCESS:




Figure 4: "Definition of PROFINET Devices Present in Network" window

By Pressing the "**PROFINET Access**" button from the main window for SW67B71 (Fig. 2) the window "Definition of PROFINET Devices Present in Network" appears (Fig. 4).

This section is used to define the list of the PROFINET slaves to read/write with the PROFINET Master. It is possible to add the PROFINET slaves from the hardware catalog. If a new device will be connected, it is possible to instal the GSDML file.

The means of the fields below are:

- ▶ If the field "Name of Station" is checked, the name of the PROFINET slave is defined;
- → In the field "IP Address" the IP Address of the PROFINET slave is defined;
- → In the field "Update Time [ms]" the delay used for IO communication is defined;
- → In the field "Answer TimeOut" the allowed number of cycles without response from the slave is defined.

Warning:

The data from/to the slaves are mapped consecutively into the IN/OUT PROFINET arrays, following the order with which they are defined.




Figure 5: "Definition Module and/or Submodules of PROFINET Device" window

By clicking on "Modules" button, it is possible to import the modules for the selected PROFINET slave device. The window "Definition Module and/or Submodules of PROFINET Device" appears (Fig. 5). In the main table it is possible to import the Modules of the PROFINET device in use. In the properties below, it is possible to set the parameters of the slave. These options depends on the slave in use, refer to the manual of the PROFINET device.

The means of the checkboxes inside the table are:

- → If the field "Map Only Data" is checked, only the data of the modules are mapped into the Modbus map. Otherwise, for each module there will be the status of IN and OUT areas too (1 byte);
- → If the field "Different Word" is checked, the data of the different modules are mapped in different and consecutive Modbus words without splitting them.

UPDATE DEVICE:

By pressing the "**Update Device**" button, it is possible to load the created Configuration into the device; and also the Firmware, if necessary. This by using the Ethernet port.

If you don't know the actual IP address of the device you have to use this procedure:

- ▼ Turn OFF the Device;
- Put Dip2 of 'Dip-Switch A' in ON position;
- Turn ON the device
- Connect the Ethernet cable;
- Insert the IP "192.168.2.205";
- Select which operations you want to do;
- → Press the "Execute update firmware" button to start the upload;
- ♦ When all the operations are "OK" turn OFF the Device;
- Put Dip2 of 'Dip-Switch A' in OFF position;
- Turn ON the device.

If you know the actual IP address of the device, you have to use this procedure:

- Turn ON the Device with the Ethernet cable inserted;
- Insert the actual IP of the Converter;
- Select which operations you want to do;
- Press the "Execute update firmware" button to start the upload;
- ▶ When all the operations are "OK" the device automatically goes at Normal Mode.

When you receive the device, for the first time, you also have to update the Firmware in the HD67B71 device.

Warning:

If Fig. 7 appears when you try to do the Update try these points before seeking assistance:

- Check if the serial COM port selected is the correct one;
- Check if the serial cable is connected between the PC and the device;
- Try to repeat the operations for the updating;
- Try with another PC;
- Try to restart the PC:
- Check the LAN settings;
- Operating System;
- ▶ If you are using Windows Seven, Vista, 8 or 10 make sure that you have the administrator privileges:
- In case you have to program more than one device, using the "UDP Update", you have to cancel the ARP table every time you connect a new device on Ethernet. For do this you have to launch the "Command Prompt" and write the command "arp -d". Pay attention that with Windows Vista, Seven, 8, 10 you have to launch the "Command Prompt" with Administrator Rights;
- Pay attention at Firewall lock.




Figure 8: Mechanical dimensions scheme for HD67B71-xxx-A1
